Senator Donaldson moves the previous question, she is seconded by Senator Heson. The decision moved to a vote via poll, and both are approved separately with votes of 42 Yay, 0 Nay, 0 Present.

Senator Heson moves to add Senator Wamble and Senator Butler to the roll, he is seconded by Senator Keyes.
